



Installation Instructions

Recommended Tools:

- Commercial Cordless-Drill
- #1 square-drive and 5/32 hex bits
- Measuring Tape
- Level
- Hand Saw (if custom lengths)

Slammer Provided Materials:

- Stainless Mounting Hardware
- Track Alignment Tool
- Installation Instructions

Installation Steps:

- Determine where on the dock face you want your fenders attached; ensure sufficient substructure is available for securely fastening at least six (6) screws through track and into dock's structure.
- Pre-set #10 mounting screws into three (3) upper most of mounting track's six (6) pre-drilled holes.
- Top edge of track has two (2) pre-installed set screws. Be certain top edge is facing up.
- Align top of mounting track slightly below top edge of dock face or at the elevation desired.
- Drive top center screw through mounting track and into dock face / substructure.
- Level the mounting track and drive a second stainless screw. Check with level and then drive the remaining stainless screw ensuring screw heads are flush with mounting track's face.
- Holding the fender with bolt-ropes facing inboard; guide the bottom bolt-rope into the bottom mounting slot (approximately 1/2") and then guide the top bolt-rope into the top mounting slot and slide fender into place.
- **Tighten down all set screws** with drill (two screws per 40" section of mounting track) to prevent fenders from sliding

Best practices:

- Install all track utilizing (3) screws per-track
- Use 4" Dacron Track Alignment Tool to position the next piece of track. BE certain that the Alignment Guide slides cleanly from one track to the next adjacent section.
- Once all track is installed, slide one fender along the entire length to be certain fenders will slide easily into place. Once all tracks are installed and alignment is perfect, install all remaining screws.
- If the weather is hot, foam will expand slightly; use dish soap or a dry-film lubricant (marine grade silicone spray) to reduce friction.
